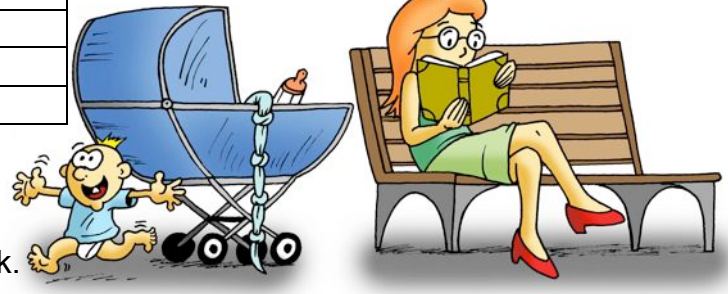


7.1. Odd one out:
