Andy Warhol



Andy Warhol was a painter and a film-maker. He is one of the 20th century's best-known artists. He became famous in the 1960s through a series of "Pop art" paintings of soup cans, film stars and car crashes.

Andy Warhol is born in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. He is the son of Czech immigrants. He goes to a commercial art school. In 1949 he moves to New York City and begins a successful career in magazine illustration and advertising. He makes shoe advertisements.

In 1962, he becomes an overnight sensation when he shows his pictures of Campbell's Soup cans. He is the leader of Pop art, which

takes its subjects from the worlds of advertising, packaging, and television. Sometimes he

duplicates his pictures with variations of colours. He makes the famous portraits of Marilyn Monroe.



Andy Warhol writes books. He also makes films. Several of these have one-word titles: *Trash*, *Bad* and *Sleep*. When he dies in 1987 he leaves a fabulous fortune. But opinions on him are divided. To some he is a genius, to others just a brilliant con man.
