..... It includes everything that exists – from the Earth to the most distant parts of space. The distances are so vast that it takes billions of years for light to reach us from the edges of it.

..... They are rodents like rats, squirrels and beavers. A *rodent* means gnawing animal. They live all over the world. Some live in deserts, others in rainforests.
