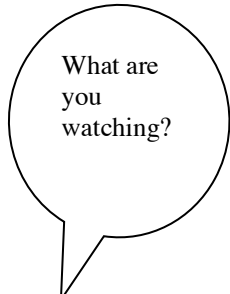


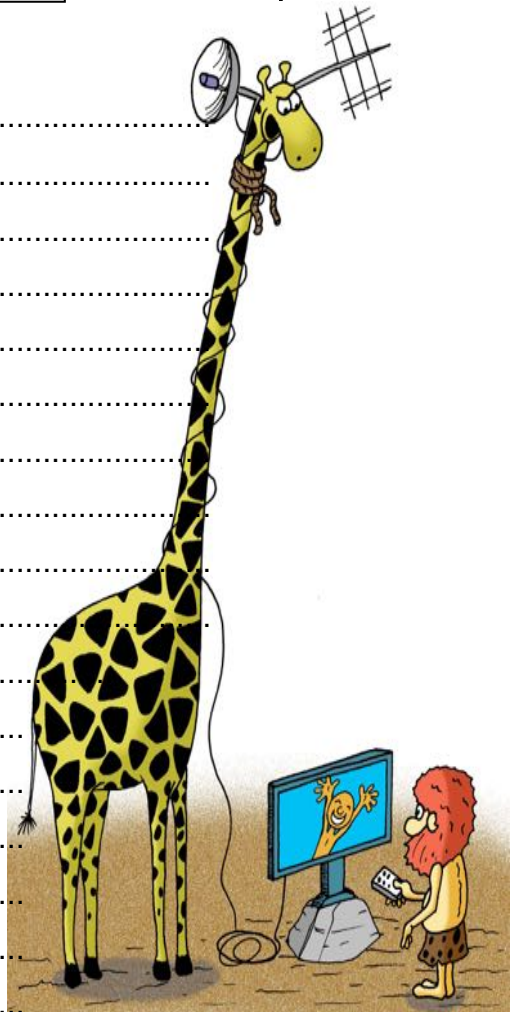
Open questions are introduced with a question word (and the answer then consists of a sentence or partial sentence): **WHERE do you live? In Spain.**

| After WHO : Don't use DO (because „who“ is the noun): | |
| Who comes every day? | Which person? |

- you WHERE live
- WHO speak French
- you WHY smile*
- she WHAT read*
- WHO sleep*
- he WHY cry*
