Subject + be + VERB+ing

I'm reading we're reading
 you're reading you're reading
 he's reading they're reading
 she's reading

Regular: read - reading

Silent E is dropped: write - writing

Short stressed vowel doubles a following consonant: run - running (*but:* open - opening)

Change into the present continuous tense (=into the progressive present):

Kevin (work) in his garden. ...Kevin is working in his garden.

He (cut) the grass.

Sue and Terry (play) tennis.

Your dog (run) after a rabbit.

Mark and Jane (listen) to CDs.

They (sit) on the floor.

We (go) for a walk.

She (swim) in the pool.

Our neighbour (wash) his car.

His daughter (help) him.....

What you (do)? – I (study) the timetable.

you (do) your homework? No, I (write) an email.

he (eat) a cheeseburger? - No, he just (drink) a coke.

She (wait) for the bus.

He (buy) an ice cream.

I (feed) the cats.
